<p>The Director of Inland Fisheries may approve brown trout for stocking of ponds and dams for public fishing, subject to the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A preferred minimum surface area of dam 2.5 Ha or 25,000 m² • That the landowner to enter into a Farm Dam Access Licence Agreement with the Inland Fisheries Service. • That there be provision of reasonable public access to the water equivalent to one of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Unlocked gates providing direct vehicle access to the water or to parking within easy walking distance of the water (less than 500m). 2. Foot access from a public road. A safe parking area must be available within easy walking distance of the water(less than 500m). 3. Access, as described in 1 or 2 above, by prior permission. Including signage displayed at the access point with landowners contact details including a mobile phone number. All reasonable requests for access to be granted. • That the landowner maintains public liability insurance. • That the Inland Fisheries Service conduct a safety assessment and inspection of the water and access.

5. Conditions of Consent (if granted)	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The property owner retains the right to restrict or suspend access due to farming operations. 2. Anglers Access signage and infrastructure may be supplied, installed and maintained by the Inland Fisheries Service. 3. Water(s) location details will be made available to the public. 4. The Inland Fisheries Service will transfer brown trout to the nominated water subject to availability. 5. All Inland Fishing regulations apply to the stocked water including open season dates and the need to hold a current inland angling licence.
