

# Go trout fishing and win up to \$50 000\*

## *Tasmanian Tagged Trout Promotion*

2020-21 Angling Season



Before the start of the 2020-21 season five tagged brown trout will be released into lakes around Tasmania. One each into Arthurs Lake, Lake Burbury, yingina / Great Lake, Lake Pedder and Lake Rowallan.

**The tags are blue and have unique identifying details.**

Each tag is worth **\$10 000** to the angler that returns the fish to the Inland Fisheries Service (\*conditions apply).

## **Terms and Conditions:**

**1** The Tasmanian Tagged Trout Promotion (Promotion) is being conducted by the Inland Fisheries Service (IFS) ABN 33 294 522 909. **2** Entry is open to holders of a current angling licence under the *Inland Fisheries Act 1995*. Licenced junior anglers under 18 and children aged under 14 must have the permission of their parent or guardian to participate (Eligible Entrants). **3** Employees and contractors of the IFS (including their immediate families) are ineligible to enter. **4** The Promotion commences at 00:00, 1 August 2020 and ends at 23:59, 2 May 2021. **5** The IFS will release five tagged brown trout, one each into Arthurs Lake, Lake Burbury, yingina / Great Lake, Lake Pedder and Lake Rowallan. The tags are blue and have unique identifying details. **6** To win, Eligible Entrants must catch the tagged fish from the designated Promotion waters and contact the IFS to claim a prize within 72 hours of capture and no later than 17:00, 3 May 2021. **7** Fish caught in the Promotion must be kept with tag intact for verification. **8** Prizes will only be awarded for fish caught using a rod and line and in compliance with the *Inland Fisheries Act 1995* and subordinate legislation.

### **Prizes**

**9** Eligible Entrants that submit a fish with a valid tag will be able to claim a prize of \$10,000.

### **Claiming a Prize**

**10** To claim a prize an Eligible Entrant must:

- a. at the time the fish is caught:
  - o i. record the location, time and date that the fish was caught;
  - o ii. measure the length of the fish;
  - o iii. photograph the fish with the tag still in place; and
- b. phone 1300 IN FISH (1300 463 474) between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday, or email [infish@ifs.tas.gov.au](mailto:infish@ifs.tas.gov.au), within 72 hours of capture and no later than 17:00, 3 May 2021 to report your catch.

**11** IFS will provide Eligible Entrants with a Prize Claim Declaration Form. **12** The Prize Claim Declaration Form will require Eligible Entrants to confirm the date, time and location of the catch, tag unique identifying details and their compliance with these Terms and Conditions.

### **Prize Verification**

**13** Before awarding a prize, the IFS will verify the validity of entries and eligibility of entrants. The IFS may refuse to award a prize to any individual who the IFS reasonably believes has breached any of these terms or engaged in any unlawful or other improper conduct in participating in the Promotion. **14** Prize winners will be notified within 14 days of the IFS receiving and verifying a Prize Claim Declaration Form. **15** Winners agree to their details and image(s) being published by the IFS for non-commercial promotion and/or publicity purposes. **16** Prize money will be paid to winners by electronic funds transfer within 28 days of the IFS notifying the winner that the Prize Claim Declaration Form has been verified.
